From its opening in 2008, the museum has gradually expanded its exhibition and programming. 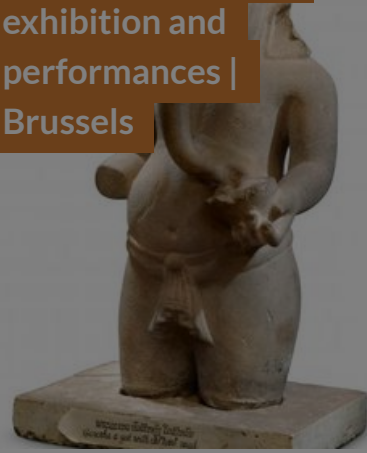
